

Fees

FULL MEMBERSHIP has a one-time **\$50.00** initiation fee and current yearly dues of **\$425.00**. As a full member, you will be assigned to a room and issued a key to the club, which allows you year round access. You will also receive a membership card that entitles you to attend all EICSL events (such as organized weekend parties) and receive discounts at local shops and restaurants.

RACE MEMBERSHIP is **\$50.00** per year. You are issued a membership card and are entitled to attend all EICSL events and functions. However, you are required to pay guest fees when you stay at the lodge and you are not issued a key to the building.

Guest Fees are **\$25 per Night**.

Meals-During winter months when we have a cook, meals are an additional \$25 and include breakfast on Saturday and Sunday and dinner on Saturday night.

ABOUT US

Located in the Mount Washington Valley of North Conway, New Hampshire, the club is just minutes from Attitash Bear Peak, Wildcat Mountain and other area ski resorts.

Our membership consists of 50-60 members who range in age from early 20's to mid 70's and come from various backgrounds.

ABOUT THE LODGE

We, as a membership, own our lodge. The lodge, along with those of our neighbors from the Ski-Wheelers and the Ski-Bees, was once part of a resort known as Russell's Inn. Our lodge was used to house the staff.

The lodge itself boasts 21 bedrooms, each with 1-4 beds and can sleep a total of 68 people.

Rooms are separated into either all male or all female.

Best of all, each room has its own sink!
